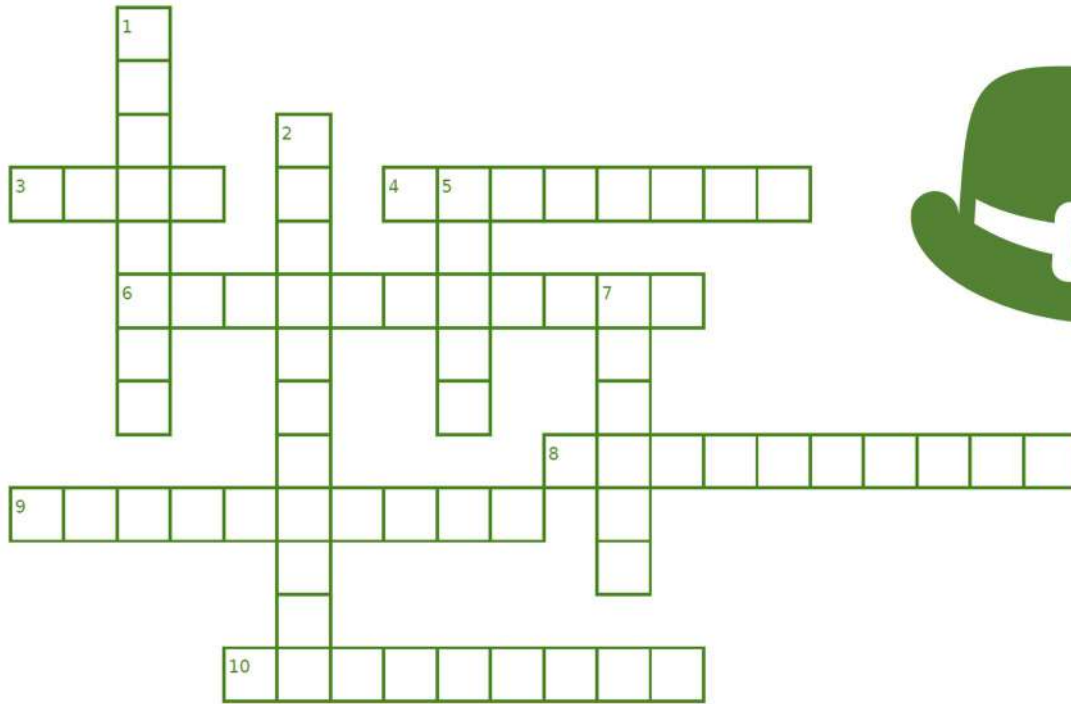


Luck of the Irish Workday Crossword

1. An individual who has shown an interest in attending your institution or who you are interested in recruiting.
2. An attribute, such as Community Learning Partner, Honors, or STEM, that you can associate with educational institutions and external associations to make them easy to find and report on.
5. Assigned to specific users to determine their access to perform certain business processes. They determine what a user can see and do in Workday.
7. Students that are grouped together for advising purposes, using criteria that you select such as grade, program of study, or class standing.

3. A business process step that you must complete.
4. A set of student applications for the same admitting level of an academic unit and the same anticipated start date.
6. The type of course group that overlaps in content to the extent that institutions deem them equivalent for various purposes/requirements.
8. Officially acknowledged business units (e.g., departments, sections, etc.) to which charges for an employee are applied. Identifies the financially responsible unit.
9. This policy is used to indicate the minimum number of units a student must enroll in to be considered a full-time or part-time student.
10. A type of security role assigned to a position that passes to the person who is hired or transferred into that position.
